Mr Halliday says the election is a great result for Livestock SA's members, with the new board representing a wide cross-section of the state and bringing a different mix of skills and experience to the table.

"We are pleased with the voting turnout of about 25 percent of members, which shows strong support for our first election and first AGM," he said.
