With more nominations than positions, Livestock SA will conduct a vote. Ballot papers will be posted to members this week and votes must be returned to Livestock SA before 5pm on Monday, August 25.

"Voting will begin shortly however only members can vote. I encourage any livestock producer who is not yet a member to contact Livestock SA or visit the website to download a membership form," Mr Halliday said.

"Successful nominees will be announced at Livestock SA's AGM on Friday, August 29, at Roseworthy Campus Tavern, to be followed by a tour of the Roseworthy facilities and the Sheepmeat Council of Australia Sheep Producers Forum."
